The Oregon Country Fair and Klamath Bird Observatory

This bird list was compiled from records collected during educational bird walks and stewardship work at the Oregon Country Fair site.

The OCF community values ecological stewardship and awareness of the biological resources on the site where it hosts its yearly event. Various volunteer crews, such as Site Crew and Vegetation Management and Erosion Control (VegManECs), work throughout the year to maintain and restore structural diversity and various native vegetation communities. The OCF Wildlife Team works with fair staff, volunteers, and vendors to increase awareness of nesting birds and accommodate wildlife found on the OCF site. Now in its 44th year, the Fair community is more motivated than ever by a shared reverence for the land and the diverse creatures that inhabit the site.

Since 2004, Klamath Bird Observatory has partnered with the Oregon Country Fair and the Master Gardener program in Community Village to increase awareness of bird and habitat conservation. Outreach focuses on birds as indicators of our environmental, social, and economic well-being. Klamath Bird Observatory and the OCF Wildlife Team lead bird walks during the Fair and document the observations to update this list.



We record the bird species observed during the fair weekend and throughout the year by using eBird, where “your bird sightings make a difference.” Look up “Oregon Country Fair” within the eBird.org website (map feature is easiest) to get an updated list or contribute your observations for free. BirdEye and BirdLog are smart phone apps linked to eBird’s data.
